

Amiodarone:

Indications/Dosage Adult VF or Unstable VT refractory to defibrillation: 300 mg IV push, may repeat 150 mg IV if dysrhythmia persists or recurs

Ventricular dysrhythmia- perfusing: 150mg slow IV push, hold if hypotension or bradycardia are observed. In general stable, patients with stable perfusing dysrhythmia should be transported rapidly with appropriate notification or the receiving emergency department.

Adverse Reactions: Hypotension, bradycardia, QT prolongation, torsades des pointes

Contraindications: Allergy to amiodarone, or iodine,
